

TURKISH AIRLINES BEGINS DIRECT FLIGHTS BETWEEN LAX - IST

In March 2011, Turkish Airlines will begin flying four times per week direct between Istanbul and Los Angeles with flights operating on Tuesdays, Thursdays, Saturdays and Sundays. This will be Turkish Airlines' fifth North American gateway, adding to New York, Chicago, Washington, and Toronto.

Great excitement surrounds this development in Istanbul, as we look forward to welcoming even more visitors from the US. In 2010, nearly 643,000 American visitors came to Turkey and with these new flights this is set to increase.
